was established in 1935.


















History of Veterinary Practice in Thailand

In the same time, there was a <u>Veterinary Para-professional School</u> under the <u>Department of Livestock Development (DLD</u>), which produced para-veterinarians, served the livestock problems until 2002.













In 2002, the <u>Veterinary Council of Thailand (VCT)</u> was established

under the Veterinary Professional Act, B.E. 2545 (C.E. 2002).



 - v) giving recommendation for government issues














