

Ryu, Pan-Dong

Pan-Dong is a professor of veterinary pharmacology at College of Veterinary Medicine Seoul National University (CVM SNU). He got DVM license in 1979, PhD degree in Iowa State University, postdoctoral training in Yale University, and joined CVM SNU as lecturer in 1991.

He has worked as dean of CVM SNU (2011~2015), AAVS (president, 2014~2015), Korean Association of Veterinary Medical Colleges (president, 2013~2015) and Korean Society of Veterinary Medical Education (president, 2013~2015). He has also served on the OIE Ad hoc Group on Veterinary Education (2015~2016), Vision 2050 Committee of World Veterinary Conference for Declaration of Incheon (Co-chair, 2016-2017) and for Journal of Veterinary Medical Education (Guest editor; 2019~2020), on the Board of Directors for Accreditation Board of Veterinary Education in Korea (2015~2021), and on the Education Committee, Korean Association of Veterinary Medical Colleges (Chair, 2015~2021) for development of a competency-based veterinary education and national model of day-one-competencies in Korea.

He published over 170 research papers in neuroscience and veterinary pharmacology and was Director of Brain Korea 21 Program (2006~2011), a national graduate research program. His current research interest is veterinary education. He is also working as Editor-in-Chief of Journal of Veterinary Science (2016~) and Journal of Acupuncture and Meridian Studies (2018~).
