Challenges of Animal Welfare and Ethics for Veterinary Graduates in Pakistan

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
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Introduction:


- Animal welfare ensures provision of food, space and treatment of animals.

- Data was analysed through SPSS software.




Response on the difference between Animal welfare and ethics



Knowledge on animal welfare and ethics, assessed throughout a five-year journey.




Over-crowding during transportation
