**Invitation to 23rd Asian Association of Veterinary Schools (AAVS) Annual Meeting
in conjunction with the 3rd International Conference of Advanced Veterinary Science and

Dear Deans and Representatives of AAVS Member Institutions,

On behalf of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Universitas Gadjah Mada, it is our honor to extend a formal invitation to the 23rd Annual Meeting of the Asian Association of Veterinary Schools (AAVS), to be convened with the 3rd International Conference of Advanced Veterinary Science and Technologies for Sustainable Development (ICAVESS) and the Southeast Asian Veterinary Schools Association (SEAVSA) annual meeting. This collaborative event will be held from **6 to 8 November 2025 in Yogyakarta, Indonesia**.

The meeting will commence on 6 November 2025 with a welcoming dinner, to which all representatives of AAVS and SEAVSA member institutions are cordially invited.

During the first day of the conference on 7 November 2025, AAVS, in collaboration with World Animal Organisation Health (WOAH), will host a session on Veterinary Education, with a particular focus on Veterinary Disaster Training and Animal Management. This will be followed by the AAVS Executive Committee Meeting.

On the second day of the conference on 8 November 2025, AAVS Assembly Meeting will be held, comprising several agendas including an administrative session for AAVS members, Kei-ichiro Maeda Memorial T&C Award Ceremony, and VetEd ASIA 2025, comprising Keynote Lectures, and Veterinary Education Research presentations. Additionally, participants will be invited to join an optional Merapi Cultural Tour, offering an opportunity to explore the unique natural and cultural heritage of the Yogyakarta region on 9 November 2025.

In addition to the AAVS Annual Meeting, participants from AAVS member institutions are invited to attend the full scientific program of ICAVESS 2025, which will include plenary lectures, panel discussions, and paper presentations. 3rd ICAVESS is currently calling for abstracts for ICAVESS Scientific sessions (see attached flyer for details).

To support logistical arrangements, a registration fee of USD 50 will be applied to AAVS participants (non-presenters in ICAVESS Scientific sessions), and USD 150 (for early bird payment) or USD 200 (for regular payment) will be applied if presenting in ICAVESS Scientific

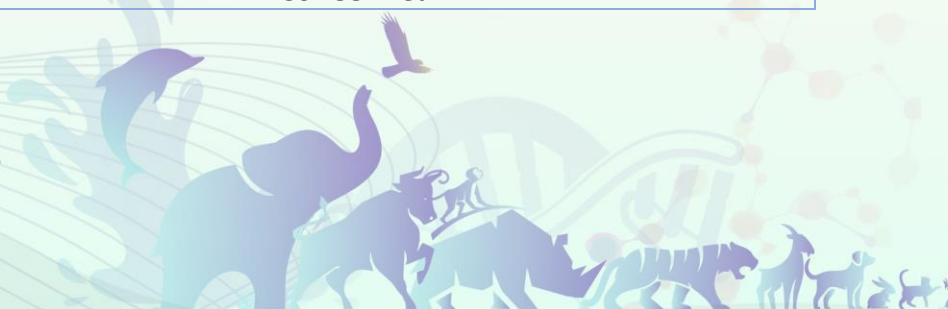
